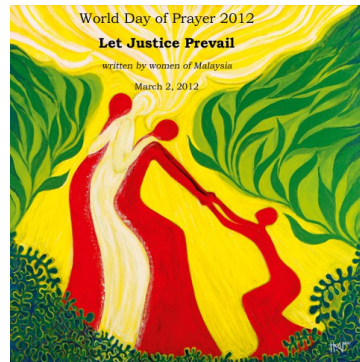
RECIPE SHARING
